In the UK Today:

- ★ **1 in 5 people infected with HIV don't know they have it!**
- ★ **1 in 350 people are infected with Hepatitis B!**
- ★ **Half of those infected with Hepatitis C don't know they have it!**

If you are infected with HIV, Hepatitis B or Hepatitis C you can remain symptom-free for years and never know it.

But:

- You can still pass the viruses to your partners or children
- You can still be at risk of liver cirrhosis and liver cancer
- You can still be at risk of developing life threatening infections and cancers

Testing is simple and early diagnosis allows people to get treatment and lead a healthy life. It also reduces the risk of transmission to others.

Should I Take the Test?

- Were you born in Asia, Africa, South America, Pacific Islands, Eastern Europe or the Middle East?
- Have you had medical or dental procedures in any of these areas?
- Have you had a blood transfusion or received blood products prior to 1991 in the UK?
- Have you had a tattoo or piercing on unregistered premises with possibly non-sterile equipment?
- Have you ever injected drugs with shared needles, even once?
- Have you had unprotected sex with anyone who could have Hepatitis B, C or HIV due to any of the reasons listed above?
- Have you shared razors or toothbrushes with anyone who could have Hepatitis B or C due to any of the reasons listed above?
- Are you a gay man and have not been tested in the last 12 months?
- Have you had unprotected sex with many different people?
- Have you ever taken recreational drugs?

If you answered yes to any of the above, you are at risk.
